FURTHER DISCUSSION OF

"OUTSIDER'S" ATTACK.

PROF. OSBORN TESTIFIES TO THE VALUE
OF SPENCER'S BIOLOGICAL CON-
CLUSIONS--CRITICISM OF "OUT-
SIDER'S" METHODS AND OPINIONS
--A DEFENDER OF KANT.

We continue to-day the publication of letters discussing the standing of Herbert Spencer as a philosopher and man of science. The attack made on Spencer by "Outsider" in the article published in THE TIMES of two weeks ago to-day has interested the believers in the synthetic philosophy, but it is evident from their contributions to the discussion that they have no fear that Mr. Spencer's standing will be in any degree shaken by "Outsider's" criticisms.
